



MOVING CHECKLIST

- Determine the date you need to be moved out of your current home

- Determine the date you're moving into your new home

- Set a budget for your moving expenses
- Determine how many travel days you'll need to reach your new home
- Determine what moving supplies you'll need and where you'll acquire them
- Determine if you'll be using movers or if family/friends will help you move
- If you're using movers, call around to several moving companies to get estimates on moving costs
- Once you determine who will be helping you move, make sure they are available the dates you need
- If you'll need temporary storage for some of your items, check to see if your preferred moving company offers storage services
- Determine how many days it will take for you to reasonably pack up your current home
- Acquire a moving folder for any important documents
- Determine who can help you pack
- Check when you need to submit a change of address form to your local post office
- Notify your insurance company so they can get your renters or home insurance transferred over to your new home if needed

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Will you need to set up utilities for your new home or schedule the termination of utilities for your current home?
- Do you need to switch your internet over to your new home?
- Is there anything you can work on [downsizing](#) before the move?
- Do you need to notify a leasing office or HOA of your upcoming move?
- Will you need to find new doctors? If you're moving far away from your current home, make sure you call around to your new location to find the doctors and providers you'll need.
